Alexander, Sally	<b><i>Mom Can't See Me</i></b> A 9-year-old girl describes life with her mother who is blind. 1990. (Out of print—check your public library.)
Alexander, Sally	<b><i>Do You Remember the Color Blue?</i></b> Common questions kids ask about blindness. 2000.
Alexander, Sally	<b><i>Mom's Best Friend</i></b> Describes how a child's mother adjusts to getting a new guide dog. 1992.
Arnold, Caroline	<b><i>A Guide Dog Puppy Grows Up</i></b> Follows a puppy-in-training through its placement with a blind person. 1991. (Out of print—check your public library.)
Kennedy, Patricia	<b><i>Through Otis' Eyes: Lessons From a Guide Dog Puppy</i></b> Simple and heartfelt lessons learned while raising a guide dog pup. 1997. (Out of print check your public library.)
Laurenson, Diana	<b><i>Guide Dogs: From Puppies to Partners</i></b> Brief explanation of how guide dogs are bred, raised and trained in Australia. 2002.
Moore, Eva	<b><i>Buddy: The First Seeing Eye Dog</i></b> Describes Buddy's training in the 1920's by Morris Frank who helped found The Seeing Eye. 1996.
Patent, Dorothy Hinshaw	<b><i>The Right Dog for the Job</i></b> Ira, a dog trained to do therapy work, makes a career change to guide dog. 2004.
