We are pleased to announce the 10th Annual Guide Dogs of America (GDA) Car Show. I have attached information about GDA, and the show, with this letter. **The show will be held at Magna City Park on June 9, 2018. (8950 W. 2600 S. Magna, Utah 84044).**

The expenses of breeding, training, medical care, and housing for the dog, as well as training the recipient, are paid for entirely out of donations and exhibitions such as ours. The cost to deliver one is in excess of \$42,000 per dog and so far, GDA has delivered over 2000 canine friends, free of charge to sight impaired recipients.
