The partnership between GDA and IAMAW began in 1948 because Joseph Jones, a retired IAMAW member who lost his vision, was rejected by then existing guide dog schools because of his age. Joseph decided to start his own school and turned to his union brethren. The IAMAW felt it was wrong to discriminate against a person because of his age and supported Joseph in the founding of a new guide dog school without an upper age limit policy.

GDA continues to expand its nondiscrimination policy and determines recipients without regard for age, gender, race, religion, ethnicity, or economic means.

Although GDA is an independent organization, historically the GDA President is a former IAMAW employee. GOA is appreciative of the IAMAW's continued support and excited about the boundless potential of the GDA/IAMAW collaboration.


