CAR SHOW RULES

- Stock: Means (for our show) can have up to three (3) subtle body/paint mods, can have bolt-on accessories whether stock or not, but must be running stock drive train, engine and interior.
- Street Rods: Means (for our show) any pre-1949 vehicle with non-stock engines or modified stock engines and/or drive train and suspension.
- Street Machine: Means (for our show) any post-1948 vehicle with non-stock engines or modified stock engines and/or suspensions, body or interior mods.
- Pro Street: Means (for our show) any vehicle that emulates a narrowed axle drag car that performs on the street and strip (tubs, roll cage, extensive frame mods, etc.).
- Muscle Cars: Means (for our show) closely emulating the factory high performance cars of the period with only modest changes or bolt-on accessories.
