This organization created by a merger in 2020 provides guide dogs to visually impaired individuals and service dogs to individuals with disabilities across the U.S.

The tournament will be a "scramble" format with a shotgun start at **9:00 a.m.** for all golfers. Cash prizes will be awarded to the first and second place teams, long drive, and closest to pin.
